WHAT 'S INCLUDED?

- Transport from Playa Del Carmen (Down Town) to dive sites and return
- Tanks (air and EAN32 for nitrox certified divers)
- Weights, weight belts and light
- Food and drinks
- Equipment storage for multiple days

WHAT'S EXTRA?

- Cenotes entrance fees.
- Pick-up from remote locations outside Playa Del Carmen and return (10-40 USD).
- Diving equipment (check equipment rental price list).

Tour prices vary depending on the distance from Playa Del Carmen to the dive sites. The cenotes have an average access cost of 20-25 USD; cenote owners may charge an additional fee for the use of cameras and drones (15-100 USD).

Save 10% on your dives when you book multiple days of cave diving with us. These prices include private guiding for you and your buddies, filled with 32% nitrox, weights, transportation from Playa del Carmen DownTown to the cenotes and back.
