As a non-profit organization, Model NATO Germany is dedicated to ensuring a sustainable future for NATO as an institution of collective defense. Our mission is to empower the next generation of decision-makers and passionate students with a profound understanding of NATO's values, decision-making processes, political intricacies, and its pivotal role in transatlantic security.

During a 4-day long scenario simulation in English, we will grant 96 students and young professionals from Germany and abroad the opportunity to address a crisis situation within the mechanisms and processes of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization. Filling the roles of National Representatives working in delegations, the students will have to coordinate their actions beyond their assigned committees and negotiate their standpoints within both the North Atlantic Council, the Military Committee as well as a scenario-dependent third committee.

As a team member in the logistics department, your task is to contribute to the overall logistics concept. You support the planning, preparation and execution of the physical aspects of Model NATO Germany: Event location, accommodation, transport, communication and information infrastructure, catering, technical infrastructure, social events as well as communication and coordination with third parties involved in the event logistics. As part of this job, you will take over individual aspects of the logistical planning from initial conception to execution.

Generally, we are looking for people who are interested in security policy and NATO-related issues. Additionally, a certain degree of English and German is a must-have. Specifically for the position in question, we are looking for people with strong organizational skills, holistic thinking, who are reliable and have a hands-on mentality. Experience in event management and strong communication skills, both written and verbal, are desirable.

We offer the opportunity to become a part of Model NATO Germany, gather valuable experience with project management and building a logistical infrastructure for approximately 130 people involved. In addition, you will become part of a comprehensive network while working in a great team of students who are enthusiastic about security policy.
