
ALICANTE

Alicante is a medium-sized city on the east coast of Spain, bathed by the Mediterranean Sea, and the capital of the well-known Costa Blanca.

Alicante is the second-largest city of the Valencian Community with an estimated population of around 350.000 people.

Alicante enjoys an average annual temperature of more than 18°C, with mild winters and hot summers that entice visitors to enjoy the water and the beaches.

OUR SCHOOL


OUR SCHOOL is divided into four stages, two of which are compulsory:

- Preschool: 3-4-5 year old students
- Primary: 1st to 6th grade (6 to 11-year-old students)
- Compulsory Secondary Education: 1st to 4th grade (12 to 16-year-old students)
- Upper Secondary Education (Bachillerato) optional - 1st and 2nd grade (17-18 year old students.
- We also have 3 Special Education Needs classrooms.

Type of school: Private school (financed by the State), we call in Spain "Colegio concertado". We have male and female students.

Number of students: about 1300 (between 25-30 in each class)- 3 different classrooms for each grade.

Number of staff: about 90 teachers.







How do we work with our students? School Facilities

Information and Communication technology is seamlessly integrated into the way we learn. All classrooms are equipped with data projectors and smart boards, whilst other have Apple Television receivers and LCD screens. The oldest Primary students and Secondary students use an Apple iPad device. Internet facilities are also available for research and study when students are not in the classroom.





School Facilities

The main building houses a fully-equipped theatre for 300 people, a library for 100 people, two computer labs, an art room, two music rooms, a big co-working area that we call "The rock" (the school is placed in a small hill and we can see here part of the real rock), two green rooms for chroma key filming, separate laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, and Biology, a medical room and, of course, a big lunch room for 400 students.



School Facilities

The school's commitment to outdoor and physical education is reflected in the sports facilities which include: A gym, three hard courts for football, basketball and handball (the sport the most students practice here), and a large sports hall for 600 people seated. The cafeteria is also in this building.

The Early Years are includes a lunch room especially for small children, a music room, a multi-purpose room, and outside playing areas with direct access from classrooms.
