

SECRETS OF BARREL-MAKING

A town in the Loire region, until the eve of the First World War, Chécý's activity was strongly focused on farming and the wine trade, as well as barrel-making. With nearly 3000 items, the Cooperage Museum retraces the making of barrels, the making and storage of wine, as well as the daily life of the peasant-winegrowers of the past through the winegrower's house and its agricultural out-buildings.
