



Campsite regulations of the Donauwörth Canoe Club

- Each guest is obliged to register at the entrance to the clubhouse (self-registration under the balcony or at the campsite service) without being asked, or to pay the overnight price immediately.
- Groups of 10 or more must be pre-registered.
- The guests will be assigned a place by the campsite service. Motorized vehicles are to be parked outside the site in the designated parking spaces. Driving on the meadow and paths is prohibited!
- Open fire is only possible after consultation with the campsite service, boathouse warden or board. Watch out for flying sparks. This does not apply to cooking with gas cartridges.
- The digging of ditches is prohibited. Dogs are generally to be kept on a leash. Paths, entrances and exits, as well as the boat entrance and the slide into the water must always be kept clear. The flagpole is not a clothesline post!
- Waste must be disposed of separately at the designated locations (waste separation). Dishes may only be cleaned in the scullery.
- For stays of more than a week, tents are to be moved upon request.
- Too economical use of drinking water in the showers and electricity is stopped! Personal hygiene is only to be carried out in the shower rooms.
- Urinating and defecation outdoors lead to immediate dismissal!
- There is night rest from 11 pm to 6 am.
- The instructions of the Board of Management and its authorized persons must be followed.
- The canoe club assumes no liability for personal injury or damage to property. We are also not liable for theft.
- Violation of the campground rules can result in expulsion from the campground.
