



Pemba Sherpa

Teaching in Hile Nigale, Nepal

Achievement

1. Ran classes outside during the lockdown break of ten days

First, we were taken a lockdown break of a week. Gradually, the corona cases prevailed highly. Therefore, whole community members made a decision to extended 10 more days of lockdown break. During the 10 days of break, I took a class outside in an open space with different small groups of children. During those classes, I mainly guided students with their reading skills with both of Tibetan and English.



2. Meeting with Eco-club

There was a meeting with Eco-club members where we also came up with the idea of buying plastic coke bottles from the community, specially from the young people. We visited each household to give knowledge on the importance of cleanliness surrounding. The idea of collecting or buying bottles was to try to create something out of it in order to recycle it. The rate for three bottles was 5 Rupees. Eco-Club members collected 100 rupees from each household in order to purchase bottles. Additionally, It was a sort of teaching and creating job opportunity for kids to bring a little sense of earning money with their own hard work.

Meanwhile, it was great seeing smile on my kids' face once receiving their payments of their hard work.



3. Have been working on English reading improvement:

Right after my 15 days of break, I normally guided students with our daily weekly routines, however, mainly encouraging students to read more books both inside and outside of classroom. I am individually guiding reading to them. Academically, I need continue to doing it more for October month as well.

4. October month goals:
