1. Logo project (Landgraaf)

- 2. Creating and working on assignments for students on Wednesday and Thursday afternoon: "What to do before, during and after exchanges!" Deadline for sending in final results 1st November!

Before the exchange:

First we start with a questionnaire about the sport and its classification (Paula and Martijn).

Both groups need to know about history, description, used materials, space and rules of the sport. Host students have practised the sport that will be brought in and have already done orienteering in their own school. Using Google Earth before makes students familiar with orienteering: how to make and use maps (Martijn).

During the exchange:

Practising, analysing and adapting the rules for gender inclusion. Students work together in an international context and compare their results (Tim). Which rules would they change? Besides that all students write a diary!

After the exchange:

Creating a page of a digital news paper including the sports with the adapted rules. Finally everybody sends the results to Jessica to be uploaded in Moodle Classroom, we all use the same form to work in.

Possibilities: Cultural trips, visiting a sports match, orienteering, practising sport brought in, on Friday evaluation and finishing products
