1. WEDNESDAY MEETING

The Wednesday meeting is intended as an accessible way to talk to each other and to give the LGBTIQ+ community a permanent place in the region. The pattern of every third Wednesday of the month at 7.30 pm in Café Grenswerk will remain in place for the time being. So please tell your friends and acquaintances.

2. MAKING A MAIN TEAM

As I have announced before, an LGBTIQ+ association can only be successful if there are people who are willing to take the lead. After three meetings and some fun activities, we have attracted some attention within the community. But it can always be more. To coordinate the plans, ideas and activities, we are thinking of a fixed group of about six people. Each person is given a task:

- Two spokespersons
- Two for communications and pr
- Two finance/fundraising

The nice thing about this proposal is that the tasks can be divided and there is always a replacement if the other is not available for a while.

In addition, it would be nice if each coordinator linked a provincial COC working group, depending on the interests. Most working groups are currently only active in South Limburg. That has to change. My idea is that those from the North will contact the working group coordinator in the

South to discuss whether or not some event/ activity can also take place in our region this year? Because we move within the COC network and organize things that we like ourselves, the work is therefore well-organized and easy to do

Coordinators and people who want more than just dropping by can register as a volunteer on the website of COC Limburg. Volunteers have the option of claiming costs, are insured during COC activities and can make use of training, expertise and the networks of COC Limburg.
