HOW TO PREPARE



BEFORE THE INTERVIEW

- Please send the following documents to info@loudnclear.online:
 - 1 Signed Privacy Statement (DSGVO): "Last Name_First Name_DSGVO"
 - 2 Copy of your ID card or passport: "Last Name_First Name_ID"
 - 3 Your pilot's licence number

YOUR SETUP

- Keep your ID/passport ready for a screenshot
- Pen and paper should be kept handy for notes
- Make sure your camera and microphone are working

THE INTERVIEW

- In the first part you will respond to system-generated questions related to aviation for about 15 mins (Level 4) or up to 25 mins (L4-L6)
- The second part is an open conversation of about 15 mins
- The aim of the exam is to rate your English, not your technical understanding
- It is important that you avoid yes/no answers – be talkative!
- You may use the phrase "say again" where needed
- For ATIS and ATC communication, focus on what is effectively asked

LANGUAGE USE

- Make active and differentiated use of the Tenses (Past, Present, Future)
- Use ICAO standard phraseology wherever applicable
- Remember the correct ICAO terms for numbers ("tree", "niner" etc.) and observe good radiotelephony standards ("decimal" instead of "dot")
- For Level 6: Use refined register incl. idiomatic language (but not excessively), complex grammar and discourse markers (e. g. however, on the other hand...)
