



## Disease policy

### Illness at home before the shelter

If your child has a fever higher than 38 degrees at home, you will contact the childminders for consultation. If your child feels well enough and can participate in the group, the child may come to consultation.

In the case of contagious diseases and/or childhood diseases, I adhere to the rules of the GGD/RIVM, which means that children are expected to stay at home until infection is over (such as childhood diseases), children have a fever for 48 hours and are symptom-free, such as fever and/or diarrhea and vomiting.

If your child cannot come for a day due to illness, you must inform us as soon as possible.

**Payment remains due to Carlijn Childminder Care in the event of illness.**

When can your child come:

- Your child must be able to participate in the day program.
- Spit and diarrhea free
- Not lethargic or cranky

When your child cannot come:

- If child has a fever of 38 degrees or more
- Clearly feels visibly unwell and cannot participate in the day program.
- If the child vomits or has vomiting and or has diarrhoea, your child will stay home sick until he has been symptom-free for at least 48 hours due to the risk of infection in the group.
- Contagious childhood diseases
- And with corona symptoms and positive test of child and or parents

### **Illness during childcare**

If a child has a fever higher than 38 degrees, you will be contacted and discussed about the childcare. If the group occupancy allows it and your child feels well enough, it is possible to continue the childcare.

But you are expected to have a constituency or be ready to come if necessary.

If your child clearly does not feel well and or starts to feel worse, your child will have to be picked up by yourself, family or neighbors. As a parent, you must inform us who is picking up your child.

### **Corona regulations:**

Although according to the government and media the corona policy no longer applies, it is still used in our shelter.

In the group there are also children with a clinical picture who easily become infected and can become very ill. In order to continue to guarantee safety for the entire group, we still adhere to our Corona policy within the shelter. In this situation, too, the agreed hours will be charged.

Do you or your child have corona-like symptoms? Get tested and stay at home if the test is positive! This also applies to children.

### **When the childminder is ill himself:**

Unfortunately, I can also get sick at unexpected times and that is very annoying. Or are unable to attend for any other reason.

If that is the case, I will let you know no later than 07:00 in the morning, provided this happens at night. If I become ill before or during the weekend, I will of course let you know as soon as possible.

The hours that I am not available myself, such as here with illness, are "not taken into account", you can then turn to the childminder agency for any replacement care, however, not every childminder agency always has this option due to the availability of childminders and places in their childcare or you sometimes have to drive further for emergency care.

Advice Try to make sure that you always have a constituency of family, friends or neighbours yourself.
