Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona

Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona located in Bellaterra near Barcelona is one of the major public universities in Spain. In the 2020 edition of the Times Higher Education World University Rankings, the UAB is the second Spanish university, occupying position 182 in the world ranking. In Europe, the UAB ranks among the Top 100 (84th position). Apart from its own research groups and park, the UAB is the hub of the UAB Sphere, a knowledge ecosystem that includes research centers, most of them situated on the UAB's campus. The UAB Sphere also integrates local businesses, authorities and the largest hospital network in Catalonia.
