For example, since 2011 CCB has been implementing projects that provide accommodation and other support services to migrants and asylum seekers in the regions of Monza and Milan. CCB's activities focus on developing a broad network of municipalities, associations and volunteers who work together to integrate people and who can contribute to the development of a welcoming culture for third-country nationals.

Agencia de desarollo local y Empleo de Cartagena

ADLE (Agencia de Desarrollo Local y Empleo) is an agency of the Spanish Municipality of Cartagena and the service hub for job seekers and entrepreneurs in the city and the whole province.

ADLE is at the centre of local economic development with the management of employment and training programmes, promotion of the social economy, employment placement, recovery of unused resources and management of business start-up projects. In addition, ADLE is also responsible for the execution and/or public tendering of public services. As an autonomous public institution, ADLE has the power to participate in a comprehensive manner in all programmes and projects related to employment, entrepreneurship and local development. As a result, ADLE acts as a key actor guiding and coordinating the services and policies of the municipality in close cooperation with the other local social and economic actors.



Cluj-Napoca

Cluj-Napoca, the "heart of Transylvania", is considered the second most important city in Romania as a multi-ethnic and denominational city with several universities and a dynamic business environment.

In the Municipality of Cluj-Napoca, the following principles apply as a local authority: Administrative and financial autonomy, decentralisation of public services, legality and eligibility of local public administration authorities, consultation with citizens in the resolution of civil disputes. The young and highly skilled labour force is a strong argument for placing Cluj-Napoca at the top of European cities with the greatest development potential. In 2015, Cluj-Napoca was the European Capital of Youth and later, in 2018, the European City of Sport.

Kreisstadt Dietzenbach

District town Dietzenbach - where integration is lived. Dietzenbach is the administrative centre and lies in the heart of the district of Offenbach (Hesse, Germany), not far from the financial metropolis of Frankfurt am Main. Around 35,000 people from 115 different nations live in Dietzenbach. With a proportion of 20% under-18s, Dietzenbach is also a very young town. Dietzenbach has been working with a politically authorised concept for integration since 2012. The development is based on a public participation of hundreds of citizens who discussed integration needs in different committees and includes the following topics: Living Together; Education; Work and Economy; Politics & Participation; Sport & Health. The working groups for the targeted projects on these topics take place regularly in the town hall. In addition, a team of qualified integration guides is out and about in the city, looking after the concerns and needs of citizens with a migration background.

Linköping is a city in southern Sweden and the capital of Östergötland County.

Ravenna

Ravenna is the capital of the province of Ravenna in the Emilia Romagna region, in north-eastern Italy, right on the Adriatic coast. Ravenna is rich in history, monuments and works of art and has been recognised by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site. Ravenna was once the capital of the Western Roman Empire, the Ostrogothic Kingdom, then the Byzantine Empire. Today, the territory of the province of Ravenna is divided into 10 districts. There are more than 90 towns, villages and other small residential settlements: The city has 160,000 inhabitants. About 12% of the population comes from EU and non-EU countries. Ravenna has an attractive and welcoming historic centre with countless shops and shop windows of traders and craftsmen who display a wide range of goods here. The pine forests and natural areas - rich in priceless flora and fauna - form an integral part of the Po Delta Regional Park.

RIGA CITY Riga

Riga is the capital of Latvia and the largest city in the Baltic States with a population of around 700,000. The Department of Education, Culture and Sport of the Riga City Administration is responsible for planning and implementing the city's policies in the following areas: Education, Culture, Youth, Sport and Social Integration. The department has more than 300 municipal institutions under its supervision, including: 146 kindergartens; 109 schools; 8 recreational centres; 9 art and music schools and 10 sports schools; as well as 3 cultural centres; 10 branches of the Municipality's Cultural Office; 24 branches of the Central Library; the professional orchestra "Riga"; the Riga National Sports Hall and the Riga City Education and Information Services. Thus, this department ensures diverse services for the residents and guests of Riga.

ACI (Association of Intercultural Cities) manages the Spanish Network of Intercultural Cities (RECI), an association of 20 Spanish cities promoting diversity management. These cities exchange methods, tools and best practices and participate in joint projects to promote cultural diversity. RECI was founded in 2011 and joined the Intercultural Cities Programme (ICC) launched by the Council of Europe in 2008. ACI also

coordinates the development of an anti-rumour strategy, following an innovative methodology that aims to use social diversity as a potential for changing perceptions, attitudes and behaviours among the population in order to prevent discrimination and improve coexistence. At the same time, ACI advises public and private organisations on the design, implementation and evaluation of strategic projects and work plans or government policies.
