Model NATO Germany is looking for volunteers to organize the 2<sup>nd</sup> Model NATO Germany in November 2024 as

### Awareness Officer

As a non-profit organization, Model NATO Germany is dedicated to ensuring a sustainable future for NATO as an institution of collective defense. Our mission is to empower the next generation of decision-makers and passionate students with a profound understanding of NATO's values, decision-making processes, political intricacies, and its pivotal role in transatlantic security.

During a 4-day long scenario simulation in English, we will grant 96 students and young professionals from Germany and abroad the opportunity to address a crisis situation within the mechanisms and processes of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization. Filling the roles of National Representatives working in delegations, the students will have to coordinate their actions beyond their assigned committees and negotiate their standpoints within both the North Atlantic Council, the Military Committee as well as a scenario-dependent third committee.

As an **Awareness Officer** at Model NATO Germany, you will play a pivotal role in upholding the values of inclusivity and mutual respect throughout our event. We are currently reviewing our existing Awareness policy that we are continuously extending or amending, which would also fall in your responsibility. Your primary responsibility however will be to serve as a reliable and approachable point of contact for any concerns or questions that may arise among the participants relating to Awareness topics. This will involve being readily available during the conference to address and manage any issues or conflicts that may arise, ensuring a respectful and inclusive environment for all participants.

In addition to your role during the conference, you will also be an essential member of our team during the preparation phase. You will also serve as a point of contact for the team for any conflicts or concerns that may arise and will work on eye-level with our board to ensure a fair and inclusive working atmosphere. Further, your keen eye for detail and sensitivity to language and representation will be crucial in ensuring that all content is as inclusive, respectful, and free from discriminatory language or imagery as possible.

Additionally, you will have the chance to facilitate one or more briefings on the topic of Awareness for the entire organizational team prior to the conference. Further, we'd expect you to brief your team accordingly in more depth prior. Depending on your expertise, we'd further encourage you to reach out to experts in the field for further feedback or guidance for our policies, procedures, or to provide information to the team.

To effectively fulfill these responsibilities, we require all applicants to be fluent in German and English and command a high degree of empathy and communication skills. You should be comfortable engaging in critical conversations with individuals from different backgrounds, guide conversations to an amiable outcome, and mediate effectively. You should further display expertise or keen knowledge in a range of topics concerning different dimensions of inclusivity and work autonomously and well organized.

To ensure that Awareness causes are appropriately addressed at the conference, we will dedicate two additional people from other departments to support you during the conference with any arising issues, which you will overlook. You will work independently and report directly to the Board.
