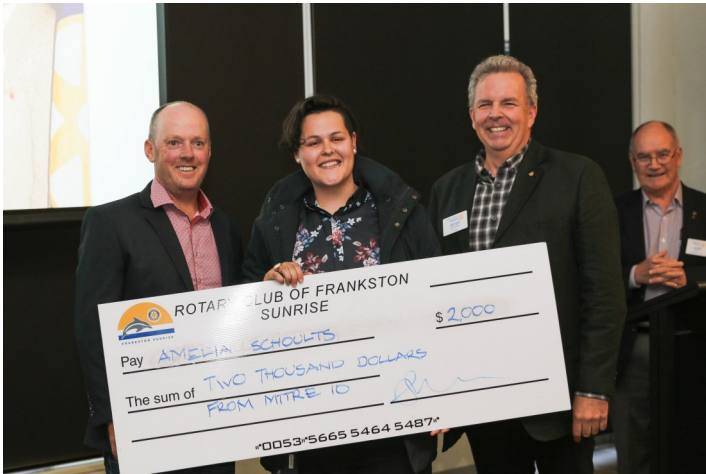

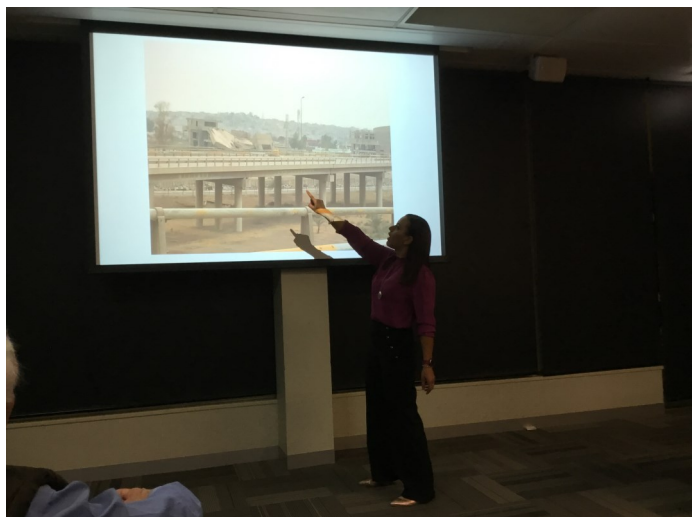
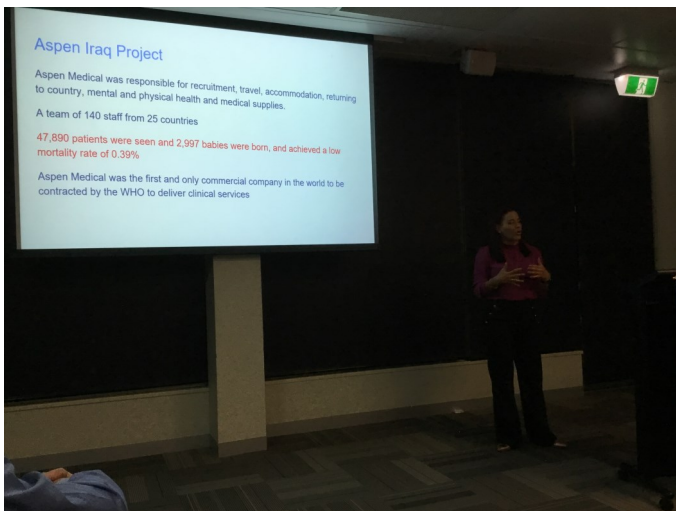

### **Community Service:**

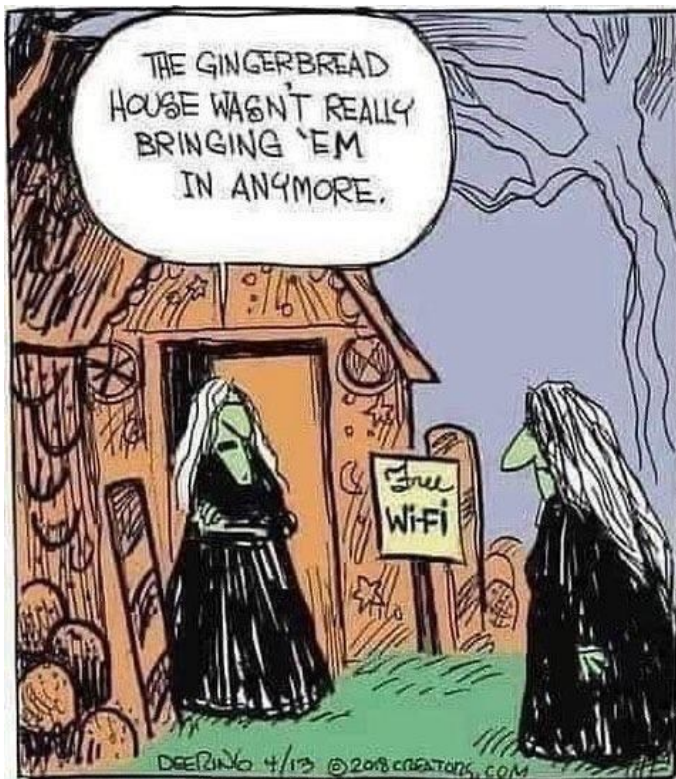
