During a four-day simulation, we will grant 96 students and young professionals from Germany and abroad the opportunity to address a hypothetical crisis scenario within the mechanisms and processes of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization. Filling the roles of National Representatives working in delegations, the students will have to coordinate their actions beyond their assigned committees and negotiate their standpoints within both the North Atlantic Council, the Military Committee as well as a scenario-dependent third committee.
