On this day in... February 17:

Event: **1917** - In Australia, Nationalist Party takes over a coalition government. **1969** - Bob Dylan and Johnny Cash record an album; it was never released. **1985** - 1st day/night game at the MCG, Australia v England. **2017** - Discovery of a new mostly underwater continent Zealandia in the South Pacific announced in research journal "GSA Today". **2020** - General Motors announces it is retiring the Holden brand in Australasia.

Births: **1848** - Louisa Lawson, Australian suffragist and writer. **1864** - Andrew Barton "Banjo" Paterson, Australian bush poet (Waltzing Matilda, The Man From Snowy River), born near Orange, New South Wales. **1888** - Otto Stern, German American physicist (Stern-Gerlach-experiment, Nobel 1943)(The Stern-Gerlach experiment demonstrated that the spatial orientation of angular momentum is quantized. Thus an atomic-scale system was shown to have intrinsically quantum properties). **1916** - Don Tallon, Australian cricketer (perhaps Australia's greatest wicket-keeper), born in Bundaberg.

Deaths: **1890** - Christopher Latham Sholes, American newspaper man, politician and inventor of the typewriter. **1958** - Hugh McCrae, Australian writer and poet (Satyrs and Sunlight: Sylvarum Libri). **1982** - Lee Strasberg, Austrian acting coach and actor (The Godfather: Part II, Somewhere in the Night). **1985** - Wanda Perry, actress (Roberta, Death of a Salesman). **2004** - Shirley Strickland, Australian athlete (Olympic gold 80m hurdles 1952, 56; 4 x 100m relay 1956).
