I	have got	haven't got (bedeutet: have not)	Have I got ...?
you	have got	haven't got (bedeutet: have not)	Have you got...?
he/she/it	has got	hasn't got (bedeutet: has not)	Has he/she/it got...?
we	have got	haven't got (bedeutet: have not)	Have we got ... ?
you	have got	haven't got (bedeutet: have not)	Have you got...?
they	have got	haven't got (bedeutet: have not)	Have they got...?

Beispiele:

Have you got a computer?

- ☺ Yes, I **have got** a computer.
- ☹ No, I **haven't got** a computer.



Has Ann got a sister?

- ☺ Yes, she **has got** two sisters.
- ☹ No, she **hasn't got** a sister.

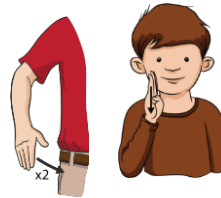

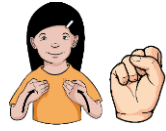
