RULES OF ADMITTANCE

The International Competition is exclusively open to chamber groups from duos to quintets.

QUARTETTO

violin-viola-cello-piano two violins-viola-cello flute-violin-viola-cello clarinet-violin-cello-piano

TRIO

violin-cello-piano violin-viola-cello clarinet-violin-piano clarinet-cello-piano clarinet-viola-piano violin-horn-piano flute-cello-piano

QUINTETTO

two violins-viola-cello-piano two violins-two violas-cello two violins-viola-two cellos clarinet-two violins-viola-cello

The participants' average age must not surpass 30 years at the time of the Prize







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REHEARSALS

PRELIMINARY ROUND friday, November 29th, 2024

The performance must last between 15 and 20 minutes featuring a piece or movement from an original work by Brahms or Schumann, if available for the respective formation.

FINAL saturday, November 30th, 2024

The performance must last between 45 and 50 minutes, with a preference for complete works. Repeating pieces from the elimination round is prohibited, except for single movements of complete works (which must be performed in their entirety for the final).
