
## Installation Instructions - With Vico Marine Circle Cutter





Put your boat cover on your boat, and mark the location where you want to install the vent. NOTE: The Boat Vent 3 should be located at the highest point of the cover.





The Circle Cutter comes with a cutting board. Place the cutting board under the canvas where you're about to cut.






Place the circle cutter over the center of your marked spot. Rotate the knob one full circle to achieve a perfect hole. WARNING: Make sure your other hand is clear of the path of the blade.






The newly cut hole should look like this.






Put the body of the Boat Vent 3 into the hole. NOTE: Make sure the canvas is not covering the threads of the vent.

## Installation Instructions - With Vico Marine Circle Cutter



Push the spiked washer snug against the canvas.



Screw the nut onto the vent. Make sure the side marked "Bottom" is facing up.




Tighten the nut as tight as possible. This will prevent it from falling off in the future.



We also sell a wrench for tightening the Boat Vent 3. This is the most reliable way to make sure the vent is completely tight.
