

F i r s t a s c e n t t o M O N V I S O 3 8 4 1 m t - N O R M A L R O U T E

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENT REQUIRED: hikers at their best trained to walk for many hours (10) even off the beaten path.

TYPE OF CLIMB: mountaineering ascent of 1200 meters of altitude difference, half of which in climbing ropes, passages on rocks up to grade II and sections of steep snow to be tackled with ice axes and crampons.

MEETING WITH THE GUIDE: Quintino Sella Refuge at 7.00 pm, the Refuge can be reached in two hours on foot from Pian del Re on an easy path.

DEPARTURE: 5:00 am, return to the Refuge at 3:00 pm

EQUIPMENT REQUIRED: 25 Lt backpack, long pants, high trekking shoes / boots (crampon in case of snow), waterproof windbreaker, hat, gloves, sunscreen, sunglasses, front battery, 1.5 liter bottle plastic that you will load at the Quintino Sella at the start, as there will be no water points along the ascent, SACK SHEET for the refuge.

TECHNICAL EQUIPMENT: harness, helmet, ice ax that you can rent at the refuge but with reservation.

ATTENTION: if the number exceeds one person, the group will renounce the Summit for safety reasons due to the renunciation of one of the participants, given the impossibility of "abandonment" on the ascent route.

PHOTOGRAPHS: during the climb the Alpine Guide will take photos, which will be sent to you only and exclusively via MONVISO OUTDOOR as the mountain guide is not authorized to send them.

PRICES: single ascent € 680, 2 people € 390 each, 3 people € 320 each. Quintino Sella 1/2 board € 60. The Alpine Guide, as regards the refuge, is charged to the customer.

PAYMENT: 25% booking deposit by bank transfer, balance to the guide in cash on the evening of arrival at the Refuge, before the Briefing with the Alpine Guide. The bank transfer will be refundable ONLY AND EXCLUSIVELY in case of cancellation by the Alpine Guide due to bad weather / unfeasible conditions of the climb (therefore total cancellation). If, on the other hand, at the time of departure from the refuge, adverse weather conditions occur such as to jeopardize the safe ascent, the guide may cancel, returning the fee, withholding € 50 per participant.

INSURANCE: the Alpine Guide has a third party liability insurance which covers damages caused ONLY in the event of his negligence. It is therefore advisable, as with all sports activities, to have your own accident insurance.

SAFETY: based on the meteorological and psycho-physical conditions of the participants, the Alpine Guide has the full right to bring the consortium back to the Refuge as soon as it deems it necessary.
