



OUR PROGRAMS

INTERCULTURAL VOLUNTEER PROJECTS

- 15 YOUTH FROM COAST TO COAST AND ABROAD MAKE A DIFFERENCE IN A LOCAL COMMUNITY FOR 2-3 WEEKS (IN CANADA, ABROAD)

SOCIAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP PROJECTS

- PARTICIPANTS CREATE AND CARRY OUT THEIR OWN PROJECTS TO MEET A NEED IN A COMMUNITY (FOR UP TO ONE YEAR)

VOLUNTEER PLACEMENTS

- PARTICIPANTS ARE MATCHED WITH COMMUNITY PARTNERS TO CONTRIBUTE TO PROJECTS FOR 3-6 MONTHS

Access in Praxis

Two day online conference on accessibility, disability justice, and anti-ableism

350+ attendees

Multiple consultations with members of the disability community, lots of research, ASL interpreters, live-closed captioning, text on screen descriptions, screen-reader friendly social media posts, free food, etc.

Personal interest X accessibility
Youth want to become engaged when they feel engaged *with!*

What makes an online event good is the same as in-person events, but the stakes can be higher!

Technology requirements & 'zoom fatigue/burnout'
Online platforms offer unique paths to accessibility...


