

SSP V15 Qualified Configurations for Credit institutions and Ancillary systems

June 2021, updated May 2022





In the tables below you can find the system components qualified by the 3CB and valid for SSP release V15.0.

Customers using totally or partially different system components or versions than the ones mentioned here are responsible to verify the compatibility between their components and the ones listed in the table below in the test environment. In such case the 3CB can provide no technical support in case of problems.

These lists will be updated at every TARGET2 release.

Internet Explorer users will rely on the same configuration (based on the local installation of the Go>Sign Desktop Client) that has proved to be stable over the previous releases for Firefox users.

Windows 10 represents the main supported Operating System.
