

# King Charles III will Display from The Royal Philatelic Collection

As previously has been reported in the GAZETTE (4-2024), the multilateral exhibition BERNABA will be organised in Bern 14–17 May 2025. Early this year, the organizers extended their invitation to King Charles III to display a selection from The Royal Philatelic Collection at the show. The collection is the postage stamp collection of the British Royal family. It is the most comprehensive collection of items related to the philately

of the United Kingdom and the British Commonwealth, with many unique pieces. The King's collection is displayed occasionally at philatelic events.

On 13 June, a meeting was held in London, where Barbara Scherer represented the exhibition organizers, and Rod Vousden is the Acting Keeper of The Royal Philatelic Collection. They discussed the selection to be made for display at BERNABA 2025.
