GET YOUR ABSTRACTS READY!

Abstracts for presentations at ISIC should meet the following criteria:

- Presentations should include **original work related to Sensory Integration** research and practice.
- All abstracts must be submitted in **English**.
- The abstract text should not exceed **250 words**.
- Should include **1-2 learning objectives** that complete the sentence: “At the conclusion of this session, participants will be able to...”:
- Should include **3-5 references** formatted in APA style that are published within the last 10 years. Include the DOI.
- Only abstracts using the official conference template and submitted online will be accepted. Abstracts will not be accepted by post or fax.

Abstracts submitted that meet the guidelines will be subject to a blind review by members of the ICE-ASI Scientific Committee.

The review will be conducted by two independent reviewers to identify the best presentations for the congress. Read the scoring criteria below carefully so you can write an abstract that has the best chances to be selected!

Scoring Criteria:

The scoring of your proposal depends upon following the submission criteria closely and completely. Blinded reviewers will use this information to score your submission.

1. Topic is timely
2. Topic demonstrates relevance to sensory integration theory and practice
3. Topic demonstrates consistency with available literature and evidence
4. Topic does not promote an individual person or their organization
5. Learning objectives are appropriate and clearly stated
6. Abstract articulates purpose and content of presentation
7. Level of material is appropriate for the identified target audience (e.g., professionals in occupational therapy)
8. References are current and relevant
9. Proposal is coherent

After the abstract submission is closed all submitters will be invited to register for the congress

Authors will be notified via email of the decision by the ICE-ASI Scientific Committee until the end of June.

At least one of the authors of an abstract accepted for presentation must enroll and attend the conference to present.
