I WAS AT A POETRY SLAM NIGHT, MY FIRST I'VE EVER ATTEND, AND OH MAN, THE RHYTHM THESE PEOPLE HAD, THE HUMOUR, THE SUBJECT MATTER, I'D NEVER SEEN ANYTHING LIKE THIS, AND THERE WAS A PARTICULAR POEM CALLED 'LIVERPOOL JUST SCORED AGAIN', THAT KEPT REVERBERATING AROUND MY MIND. FOLLOWING THIS, I WENT HOME, AND TRIED TO PUT PEN TO PAPER. AT THE TIME I STARTED THERE WAS A LOT OF DARKNESS IN MY UNIVERSITY, STUDENT SUICIDE WAS HIGH AND THERE WERE INCIDENTS OF STUDENT DEATHS WHICH LED TO A VERY SOMBRE ATMOSPHERE. SO THE FIRST POEM I WROTE CALLED 'ALONE IN A CROWD', WAS A REFLECTION OF THIS.

NEEDLESS TO SAY, THE FEELING OF BEING ABLE TO PUT MY FEELINGS ON PAGE, REAL, TRUE FEELINGS, BUT THEN IMBUE IT WITH AN ARTISTIC TWANG, RHYME, METRE, HUMOUR ETC. WAS SO THRILLING FOR ME, AND IT SEEMS AS IF THE WORDS JUST FLOWED THROUGH ME I WAS HOOKED.

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SO I STARTED WRITING A LOT OF POEMS IN MY NOTEPAD AND MY NOTES APP, AND SHARING THEM WITH MY FAMILY. I STARTED ATTENDING POETRY SLAMS AND PERFORMING AT EVENTS IN DURHAM AND IN LONDON,



WITH A POEM OF MINE BEING PUBLISHED IN 'THE NORTHERN REVIEW', A SMALL ARTS PAPER IN DURHAM.



And I haven ' t looked back since. 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Which Poets inspire you?

I REALLY LIKE EDGAR ALLEN POE'S 'THE RAVEN'. THE RHYMING SCHEME AND LANGUAGE USED IS FASCINATING AND SIMILAR TO MY STYLE. THE SIMPSONS ALSO DID AN EPISODE ON IT, WHICH IS HILARIOUS, YOU SHOULD CHECK IT OUT!

I LOVE "THE HIGHWAYMAN", "THE JABBERWOCKY", "BE DRUNK" AND GENERALLY POEMS THAT TELL ALMOST A FAIRYTALE-LIKE STORY BUT MAINTAIN AWESOME RHYME AND METRE.

AS FOR MODERN POETS AND POEMS THAT INSPIRE ME | REALLY LIKE: "WILD GEESE" - MARY OLIVER, "A SMALL NEEDFUL FACT" BY ROSS GAY AND "THE ISLAND WITHIN" BY RICHARD NELSON. THESE ARE FUN AND ARE DIFFERENT TO MY USUAL STYLE WITH RHYMING PATTERNS, THEY ALSO HIT HARD IN THE EMOTIONS.

Can you recommend any Poetry Events in London?

Unfortunately, I have not seen that many. I'm re-entering this space, and I'm excited to discover more. I remember I attended an awesome reading at Green Alley Studios near Cambridge Heath, that my friends run! They don't happen often but definitely check it out if they throw another one.
