KAYDIN FRITCHER

Kaydin Fritcher is a 12 year old Tik Tok/Instagram comedy star who has grown over 33,000 followers in just a small amount of time. The king of comedy will be talking all things Emery Bingham, family, fans and much more. Kaydin has grown a very strong fan base who always are supporting him and want to get to know him. We asked Kaydin how does he connect with his die hard fans, he told us. "By going live on Instagram and talking with them or guesing them. I try to make group chats so everyone has a chance to not only connect me but with the fandom, I also check my dm's all the time! Even if I can't reply to every single one I always make sure to read them". Kaydin also talked a lot about how important family is to him and how he's a little overprotective, "Family is the most important thing to me over anything else. I couldn't live without my little brother and sister I'm probably a little bit



overprotective, honestly my family uncles, aunts, cousins, grandparents are always together every single weekend, we cook fajitas on the grill and listen to music to about 2am. I love my family". The Tik Tok star spoke out about his time at public school before starting his first year of homeschooling. "Before homeschool public school for me since being on social media was never a normal day at school. I can't count how many times since the fourth grade I've been a victim of bullying. It's almost like kids try and take what you love doing away from you when they see

you succeeding at it. I remember in fourth grade I went to a school called golden meadows and one of the teachers called me a "jack a**" on top of kids bullying me everyday, I would come home some days and cry and ask why kids hated me and tell my mom what happened that day. She went and told the principal (who is still the principal) and she said " well I see him in the halls and he looks fine to me" I remember my moms voice echoing through the office and down the hall yelling " you never know who is being bullied! You don't know a face of bullying! You're not with My son every single night when he's having anxiety attacks from coming here everyday and getting bullied. How dare you take a glance at my son and tell me "he looks fine to you." I feel



like schools have a zero tolerance for bullying but they don't take it seriously until it's too late". Last month's cover star Sarah Dorothy Little also spoke up about her struggles with bullying and how being someone in the public eye isn't always easy at a young age. It seems more and more in the day and age bullying is getting more serious and toxic. Kaydin is most known for his comedic personality and funny videos across multiple social media platforms, we asked Kaydin what made him love comedy?. "I don't think I have any other choice lol that's just my personality since I can remember. I remember vividly the time my parents put me in tball at four years old. it was my turn to catch the ball in the outfield and everyone is waiting but I decided to take my mit off and proceeded to act like a trex being born out of a hatching egg. Comedy is what I love and improv acting is one of my favourite things to do". When asked what advice he would give to any fans who wanted to start in comedy here's what the star had to say, "Don't try to hard!! If you try to hard it's not funny. Make sure your comedy comes from within your personality and don't try and make someone else's material your own. You can be inspired by someone but always have your own twist on it". Moving onto one of the most talked about Kaydin Fritcher this year, Emery Bingham. Over a month ago Kaydin and Emery collared on a remake of pop superstar Ariana Grande's "Boyfriend" featuring Social House. The video now has over 700,00 views sparked a lot of dating rumours between the two stars. When asked about the rumours and whether or not they were true Kaydin said; "Well I knew this question was coming!! We are twelve, twelve year olds date, twelve year olds have crushes. I'm going to leave it at that". We also spoke about



the first time he met Emery in person "It was awkward lol. You know when you talk to someone online or on the phone you've never met and then you meet them in real life? Yeah it was like that! But really five minutes after meeting her it was like I've known her for forever! Emery's a boss, She's awesome". A tour/show is something that a lot of Kaydin fans want, when asked if he would be down to doing something along those lines he replied. "Yes for sure! That is something I'm hopefully one day going to achieve! I had a chance to go on a tour before.

(but I'm not paying 7,000 to be part of a tour)". Fame is a huge thing for Kaydin so we asked him when he first realised he was becoming something "I think it's flattering how people consider me "famous" but I would say back when musically had a meet and greet (when it was musically) and I went and had so many supporters coming up and wanting to make videos with me, I think that was when I realised other kids looked up to me". Kaydin also gave us a little recap of what his first fan encounter was like, "I was at a concert in Dallas at the house of blues and two girls came up and asked for a picture. It was crazy".

We asked the talent if he could give one message to his fans what would it be? He said "Thank you times one hundred because if y'all didn't believe in me I wouldn't be doing what I love". We talked to Kaydin about some of his upcoming projects and if we could expect any new original music in the future and he told us. "love music, I had my first original song at nine years old, so I was pretty much a fetus but as for anything coming up...if the right opportunity came along. I have a couple of things I'm working on at the moment, I'll be going back out to LA soon so keep a look out for those".
