Qualifications:

1. Teacher:

Individuals who hold a dance teacher's qualification, instructor's qualification, or coach's qualification issued by each association or organization. Or individuals who work for a dance school run by someone who holds those qualifications.

2. Student:

Individuals who do not hold the above qualifications and are studying under a teacher.

- Participation in a wheelchair is not allowed.
- Singles-dance, Multi-dance, Scholarship, Doubles, Trial, allows student-to-student participation.

Competition Regulations:

- Costumes are free in all sections.
- The length of the music is 1:10 for the preliminary round and 1:15 for the final round and trial.

The final round will be danced with live music.

Doubles Competition Regulations:

[1] Basic Rules:

- The competition is for pairs of two people.
- Pairs must be of the same gender.

[2] Competition Style:

- The four disciplines are Cha Cha, Samba, Rumba, and Jive.
- Any step within the range of Latin American, including basic figures, can be used.
- More than half of the overall steps danced should be single steps that do not involve any physical contact such as holding hands or placing a hand on the shoulder.
- If using an obvious leading action such as rotating the partner, the same step should be performed while swapping roles.
- The following actions are generally prohibited:
- Lying on the floor
- Kneeling on the floor for more than three seconds
- Lifting the partner
- Dancing while holding hands on the floor
- High rondes that could endanger other players
 * (Some of these rules are taken from the JDC Latin Doubles Competition Regulations)

Junior High School Division and Elementary School Division Competition Rules:

[1] Eligibility:

The eligibility is determined based on the leader's grade level as follows:

- Junior High School Division: 1st to 3rd year of junior high school
- Elementary School Division: 1st to 3rd year of elementary school, or 4th to 6th year of elementary school

[2] Other rules:

• There are no specific dress code or figure regulations.

Judging:

- The rankings will be determined by the total points accumulated in the preliminaries and the finals.
- There will be no judging for the Section Trial.

Awards:

 A trophy will be awarded to the first-place winner in each section, and certificates will be presented to those who place 1st through 6th.

Application Process

1. Start of Applications

From 10:00 a.m. September 1st, please apply via the entry form on our website.

2. Application Deadline

Until 11:00 p.m. October 4th. Please note that we may limit the number of entries on a first-come, first-served basis due to event management reasons.

3. Payment of Participation Fee

Please deposit the specified amount by the deadline in the prescribed manner. If there is no deposit, If there is no payment, we cannot accept the entry for any reason.

4. Event-Day Participation Check-in

Notes on Application:

- 1. Please apply with the responsible teacher as the applicant and make the payment under the name of the applicant in charge.
- 2. For elementary and junior high school students, as well as amateurs, please designate a representative as the applicant in charge and make the payment under the name of the applicant in charge.
- 3. If you have multiple entries, please make a consolidated payment under the name of the applicant in charge. (Please bear the transfer fee yourself.)
- 4. Please bear the transfer fee.
- 5. We will issue a receipt in exchange for the transfer statement.

Competition Notes

- 1. Please read the application agreement carefully and only apply if you agree to it.
- 2. Participants should be aware of their health and be ready for the competition.
- 3. In each section, participants will be called by their number. Please be careful not to be late.
- 4. If you enter the wrong heat, it will not be judged.
- 5. Warming up or practicing that may inconvenience others in the venue will be prohibited to avoid close contact.

- 6. Please only use the changing room for changing and manage your belongings by yourself.
- 7. Emergency measures will be taken in the event of an accident during the event, but we cannot take responsibility afterward, so please thoroughly manage yourself.

Venue Guidelines
