Paul Davies, Chair, CCUS Advisory Group



Paul Davies is Chair of the CCUS Advisory Group; a cross-industry, public-private group convened to help develop the detailed business models and accompanying legal and regulatory governance to accelerate the development of CCUS clusters across the UK.

After working as a project financier at HSBC, Paul was a project finance partner at PricewaterhouseCoopers for 20 years, advising on some of the largest UK projects, advising Government, the private sector and regulated utilities.

Since leaving PwC three years ago, Paul has chaired Storelectric, a grid-scale electricity storage company, advised DfT, Highways England and the CAA on the regulation of Heathrow.

He established the CCUS Advisory Group at the beginning of 2019, which delivered its business model report in July to back up BEIS's CCS consultation which were launched together.
