


Let's go to the GERMANY CUP 2022 !

Accommodations

Tournament mode

- Two day tournament (Saturday/Sunday)
- Each agegroup plays with min.12 teams
- · Two groups of six teams, semi-finals and finals
- All placements are played
- Short breaks between the matches
- Each team the same number of matches
- On Saturday each team plays in the morning or in the afternoon
- Association referees
- Trophies and certificates for each player

Tournament costs

• Starting-fee 69 € per team, plus 25 € for referees per team
