

Call for Travel Awards to attend the SFRR-E Vienna Meeting 2023



Dear colleagues,

We are pleased to announce the call for SFRR-E travel awards for students and postdocs to attend the 2023 SFRR-E Annual Meeting “**Redox Biology in Translation**” that will be held in Vienna, Austria from 6 – 9 June 2023.

Please note that previous SFRR-E travel grant awardees and SFRR-E Young Investigator Award recipients, who have been supported to attend the annual conference previously, are not eligible to apply.

- 6 travel awards of 400 Euros each for European PhD student members of SFRR-E.
- 6 travel awards of 400 Euros each for postdoc members of SFRR-E, who are less than 5 years post-PhD and not in permanent academic positions.
- 4 travel awards of 900 Euros each for non-European students or postdoc members of SFRR-E or a SFRR Regional Society (with the same conditions as above).

The applications should be submitted online through the SFRR-E website (<https://www.sfrreurope.org/>) as a single PDF file containing a CV (max. 2 pages), which includes the date of PhD award, a supporting letter written by the applicant, outlining your interest, and an abstract for the communication to be presented during the conference.

As registered user of the SFRR-E intranet you will have access to submit your application when you login into the website (<https://www.sfrreurope.org/>) and select the option “Call for Travel Awards for SFRR-E Vienna 2023” in the menu on the left.

The deadline to receive submissions is **10th February 2023**. The decision about awardees will be announced before the early-bird registration deadline and the corresponding funds will be transferred to the awardees soon after this announcement.

In addition, the applicants should submit their abstracts online through the conference website before 10th February 2023, which is the deadline for abstract submission.
