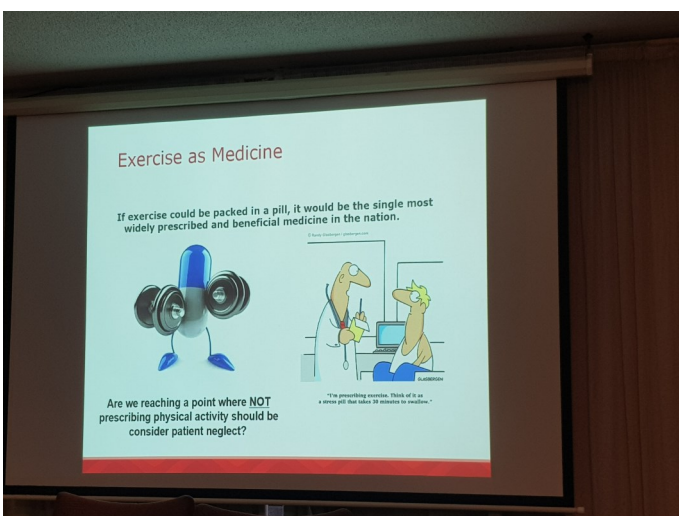

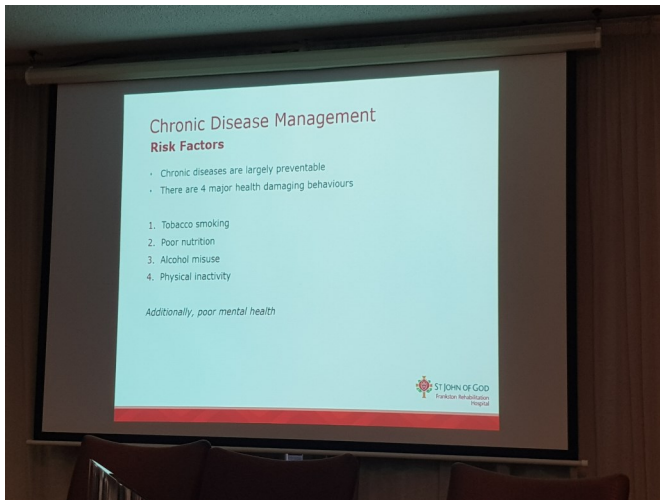
Guest Speaker: Sam Buchanan - St John of God

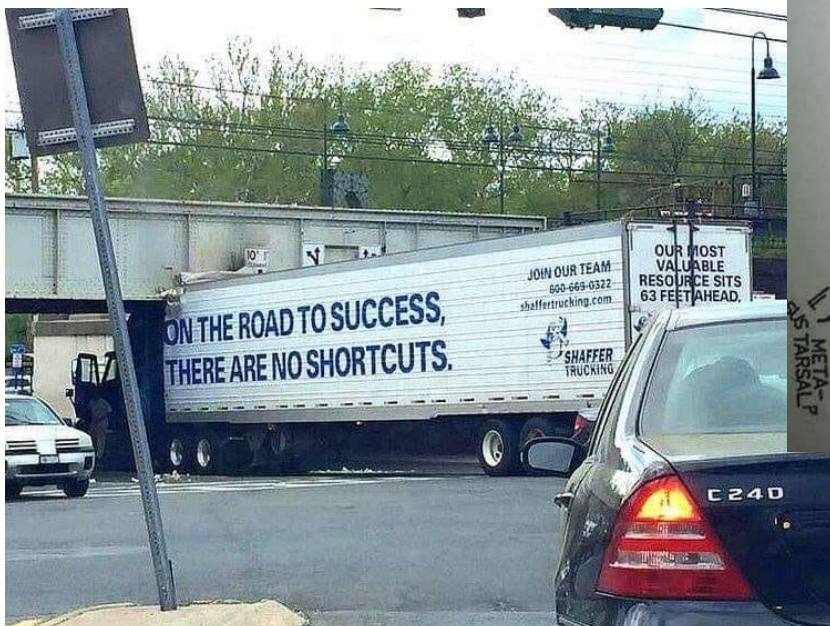
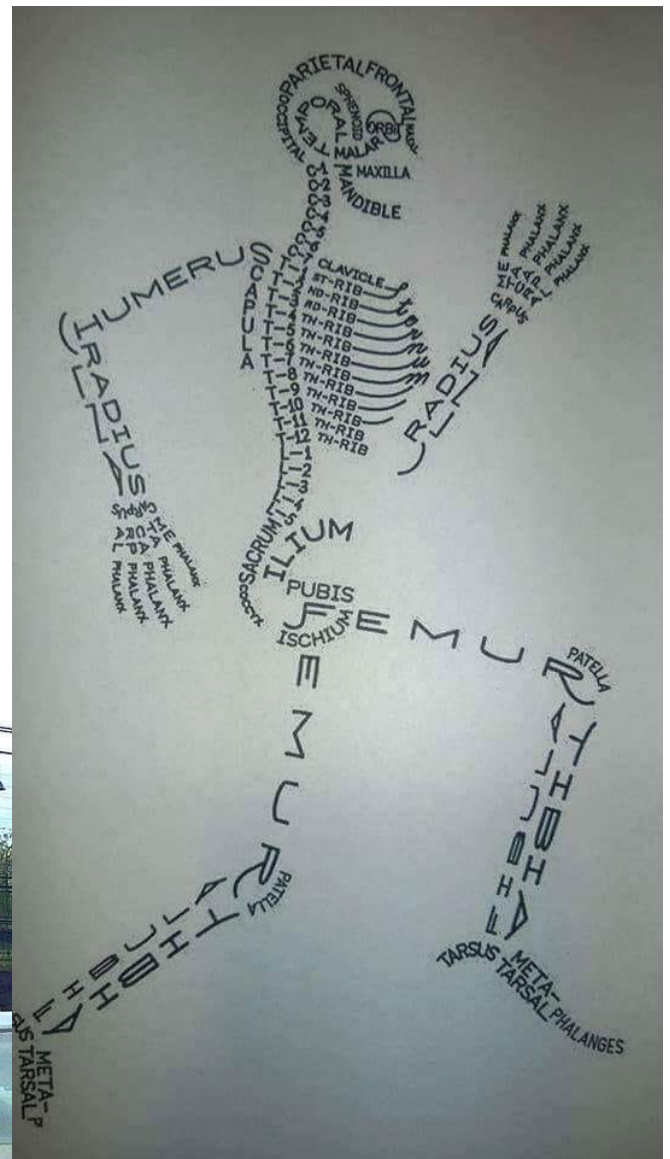
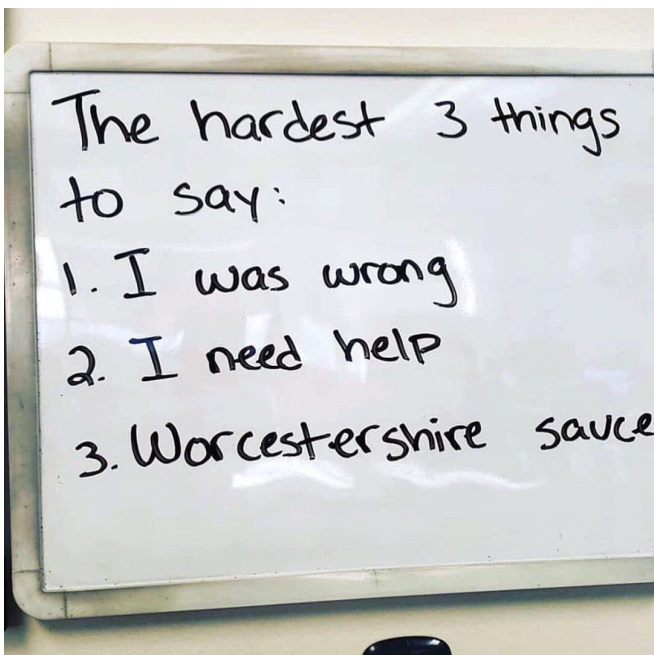
