Who	Used to ask about a person or people.	Who is the new student in our class?
Whose	Used to inquire about the owner of something.	Whose book is this?
Why	Used to ask for the reason or cause.	Why did you miss the meeting?
Which	Used to present a choice between two or more options.	Which dress do you prefer, the red or blue one?
How	Used to inquire about the manner, condition, or degree.	How are you feeling today?
How much	Used to ask about the quantity of an uncountable noun.	How much water is left in the bottle?
How many	Used to ask about the quantity of countable nouns.	How many apples are there in the basket?
