
SARAH GEORGIANA

I started when I was two years old.

But after attending a dance convention and receiving a scholarship I was like, I know for sure I am supposed to do this and someone else saw it in me too". The sometimes villainous dance teacher Abby Lee Miller is a tough one to impress, we asked Sarah what it was like meeting the one and only Abby Lee Miller?, "I had met Abby as a fan before and had a conversation with her. So meeting her I wasn't nervous about ... but auditioning for something that would change my life was nerve wracking and I had no idea how that was going to go". Now that Sarah has a huge following with over 220,000 followers we wanted to know what she would say to her younger fans that want to start a professional dance career, she said, "Work hard, never give up. There will be 100 "no's and finally a yes ... so just stay the course". On the eighth season of "Dance Moms" Sarah's mom Michelle was portrayed as some what of a villain. For any person especially a child it's not nice to see your mom on



TV being painted as a bad person. So with that in mind we asked Sarah what it was liked having



her mom portrayed as the "bad guy" on the show, she replied. "My mom is a great mom. She is kind and caring. I know who my mom is and I wouldn't be where I am without her".

Sarah is a very busy kid, from events to a tight filming schedule there is not much this kid has time for. So we wanted to know if in her free time (if any) if she could tell us about any upcoming projects she is currently working on. She told us "I'm always auditioning ... you never know". We think that that's a great state of mind. You can never even have a shot at something if you don't give it a go, so keep auditioning Sarah. We know your gonna be in movies very soon. The entire planet is holding there breath as to whether there is going to be a ninth season of the hit reality show "Dance Moms", she told us exactly what we thought she would. "I'm always auditioning ... you never know", in other words we will just have to wait, pray and see whether this worldwide phenomenon will be returning to our screens in 2020.
