Information obligations pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 GDPR

According to Articles 13 and 14 GDPR, the controller must provide the data subject whose data it processes with the information specified in the articles.

1. The name and contact details of the controller and, where applicable, its representatives:

2. Purposes for which personal data are processed:

The personal data is processed for the purpose of implementing the membership relationship (e.g. invitations to meetings, organization of events).

In addition, personal data is published in connection with sporting events, including reporting on these events on the club's website, in the club's social media presence and on the websites of professional associations, and transmitted to local, regional and national print media.

3. Legal basis on which the processing is carried out:

The processing of personal data is generally based on the need to fulfill a contract in accordance with Article 6 (1) (b) GDPR. The contractual relationships are primarily the membership relationship in the club and participation in the match operations of the professional associations.

If personal data is collected without the processing being necessary for the fulfillment of the contract, the processing is based on consent in accordance with Article 6(1)(a) in conjunction with Article 7 GDPR.

The publication of personal data on the Internet or in local, regional or national print media is carried out to protect the legitimate interests of the association (see Article 6 (1) (f) GDPR).

The legitimate interest of the association is to inform the public by reporting on the activities of the association. In this context personal data, including pictures of participants, are published, for example as part of reporting on the club's sporting events.

4. Duration for which the personal data will be stored or, if this is not possible, the criteria for determining the duration:

The personal data is stored for the duration of the membership.

Upon termination of membership, the data categories are stored in accordance with the statutory retention periods and then deleted. In the period between termination of membership and the deletion, the processing of this data is restricted.

5. The data subject is entitled to the following rights under the conditions specified in the respective articles:

- the right of access under Article 15 GDPR,
- the right to rectification under Article 16 GDPR,
- the right to erasure under Article 17 GDPR,
- the right to restriction of processing in accordance with Article 18 GDPR
- the right to data portability under Article 20 GDPR,
- the right to object under Article 21 GDPR,
- the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority pursuant to Article 77 GDPR
- the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal

6. The source from which the personal data originates:

Personal data is generally collected as part of the acquisition of membership.
