




PREVIOUSLY ON MONSTER CLUB ARCADE


































































The scepter was handed to the museum back in 1969.

> The surface is, amongst unknown inscribings, inscribed by the markings of our history's most ancient civilizations...




Recently we received an anonymous request implying we should research the scepter once again.
