Dear Parents and Guardians of Hermann School,

Time flies in the new year, so today you will receive the most important information about the Hermann School for the up coming month of February:

As of the 2nd half of the year, we welcome Ms. Sarah Böcker at Hermannschule. She comes back from parental leave with 11 hours and will work in the common learning of classes 3 and 4. We are very happy and welcome her back!

At the same time we have to say goodbye to Mrs. Laura Kalka and Mrs. Claudia Hundehöge. We would like to thank them for their extremely dedicated work at Hermannschule and wish both colleagues all the best for their future careers.

The new timetable is valid from Monday, 31.01.2022, which has been handed out to you by the class teachers.

From the 2nd half-year, starting on 31.01.2022, we have discussed within the college that all children of the Hermann School will do their Lolli tests on Monday and Wednesday. This applies to all grades 1-4. Thus, the drivers, who otherwise come to the school four times a week to pick up corresponding pools and reserve samples, are relieved and only have to pick up the tests of Hermann School on Mondays and Wednesdays.

Between 31.01. and 18.02.2022 the half-yearly parents' evenings will take place in the classes / learning groups. The invitations for these will be sent to you separately by the class teachers.

On Wednesday, 23.02.2022, the meeting of the school guardianship committee will take place at 20:00. A separate invitation will be sent to the respective parent representatives by our school council chairman Mr. Runkel in due time.

On Friday, February 25, 2022, we will celebrate carnival in our school from the 1st - 4th hour. We look forward to seeing many colorful costumes from the children. On this day there will be lessons according to the schedule.

The OGS will still send you a query regarding the childcare situation. If you have any questions regarding this, please contact Ms. Barbara Göcking. Thank you very much.

Finally, I have an important reminder for you:

Especially now in the cold and dark season, many children are brought to school by car. As a result, there is a lot of car traffic again. Cars parking in and out of cars, open car doors and children getting out of cars make for a very confusing road situation. Due to poor visibility in the dark and perhaps rain, I am very concerned for the safety of our school children.

Please do not turn your car around in front of the school, and please do not park in the teachers' parking lot! Likewise, it is forbidden to stop in front of the fire department driveway "just for a moment" to pick up children. This is an unpleasant situation for everyone involved: your children rush to get into the car, you as parents are stressed, other children can be hurt, and school staff and employees have to keep pointing out to you that the chosen course of action is not correct. Many of you are already following these guidelines - for which I thank you on behalf of your children and the entire Hermann School team. Please help us to make the way to school safe for your children!

Furthermore, in the last few weeks there has unfortunately been an increase in the exchange of various trading cards in the schoolyard.

It is a pity for your children if trading cards disappear or fall on the ground and become dirty.

Monday, 28.02.2022 (Rose Monday) is a floating vacation and therefore free of lessons.

The mutual "competition" is also not nice to experience. Within the college of the school it was decided that trading cards (e.g. Pokémons or similar) are prohibited in the school. Therefore, I would like to ask you to talk to your children about it again and to remind them that trading cards are not allowed to be exchanged or brought to school.
