**Event: 1934** - Outside Chicago's Biograph Theatre, "Public Enemy No. 1" John Dillinger is mortally wounded by FBI agents. **1960** -Cuba nationalizes all US-owned sugar factories. **1969** - Aretha Franklin arrested for disturbing the peace in Detroit. **1983** - Dick Smith makes 1st solo helicopter flight around the world. **1994** - Former NFL running back, broadcaster and actor O.J. Simpson pleads "Absolutely 100% Not Guilty" of murder. **2012** - British Open Men's Golf, Royal Lytham & St. Annes: South African Ernie Els wins his 2nd Claret Jug, 1 stroke ahead of runner-up Adam Scott of Australia.

**Births: 1713** - Jacques-Germain Soufflot, a French architect in the international circle that introduced neoclassicism. His most famous work is the Panthéon in Paris, built from 1755 onwards, originally as a church dedicated to Saint Genevieve. **1887** - Gustav Hertz, German quantum physicist (Nobel 1925 - winner for his work on inelastic electron collisions in gases). **1980** - Scott Dixon, New Zealand auto racer (IndyCar Drivers' champion 2003, 08, 13, 15, 18). **1983** - Sharni Vinson, Australian actress and model.
