Marburg Stand-Alone at a Glance

Application deadline:	April 15th for fall semester; October 15th for spring semester	
Departure from US:	Usually late March/early April for spring semester; late September/early October for fall semester. Exact program dates will be announced during application process.	
Arrival overseas:	Frankfurt am Main International Airport (FRA). All arrival times should be within the time window between 9 a.m. and noon of arrival day.	
Departure from site:	Frankfurt am Main International Airport (FRA)	
Program dates:	Late March/early April to late July	
Important:	While Achievement can provide general guidance on immigration matters, students are themselves ultimately responsible for applying for, obtaining and maintaining their legal resident status in Germany. The same applies for health insurance. All students must be covered by German health insurance for the entire duration of their stay in the Federal Republic of Germany. The <i>Ausländerbehörde</i> in Marburg will only issue residence permits for the timeframe where German health insurance coverage is in effect, and residence permits can only be issued after you have arrived in and successfully registered as a resident of Marburg.

Internships available:	There are several not-for-credit volunteering opportunities available in Marburg. Inquire for more information.	
Language(s) of instruction:	German and English. The Uni Marburg also has a strong line-up of foreign language offerings, including Arabic, Hebrew, Spanish, Russian, French. Achievement reimburses students for one course per semester at the <i>Sprachenzentrum</i> with proof that the student passed the course.	
Public transportation:	A Wiener Linien Monatskarte (Vienna) and a SemesterTicket (Marburg) covering the program dates are included in the program fee.
