



On this day in... September 30:

Event: 1791 - The National Constituent Assembly in Paris is dissolved; Parisians hail Maximilien Robespierre and Jérôme Pétion as incorruptible patriots. **1916** - Eleftherios Venizelos announces he is forming a Provisional Government in Crete as an alternative to the one in Athens; he is determined to bring Greece into the war on the side of the Allies. **1928** - Le Sifflet publishes 1st precursor of Kuifje (Tintin). **1935** - George Gershwin's "Porgy and Bess" premieres in Boston. **1942** - Admiral Chester Nimitz's B-17 finds Guadalcanal using National Geographic map. **1990** - The Dalai Lama unveils the Canadian Tribute to Human Rights in Canada's capital city of Ottawa. **1997** - John Howard's Australian government gun buy back scheme ends with more than 640,000 firearms compulsorily acquired, including many newly illegal semi-automatic rifles and shotguns. **1999** - Japan's worst nuclear accident at a uranium reprocessing facility in Tōkai-mura, northeast of Tokyo.

Births: 1627 - Robinson Crusoe, fictional character, according to Daniel Defoe. 1922 - Alan Stretton, Australian general (AO, CBE was a senior Australian Army officer. He came to public prominence through his work in charge of cleanup efforts at Darwin in the aftermath of Cyclone Tracy on Christmas Day 1974). 1924 - Truman Capote, American author (In Cold Blood). 1943 - Johann Deisenhofer, German chemist, Nobel Prize laureate (who, along with Hartmut Michel and Robert Huber, received the Nobel Prize for Chemistry in 1988 for their determination of the first crystal structure of an integral membrane protein, a membrane-bound complex of proteins and co-factors that is essential to photosynthesis). 1975 - Marion Cotillard, French actress (Inception, La Vie en Rose, Rust and Bone).

Deaths: 1948 - Edith Roosevelt, First Lady of the United States. **1955** - James Dean, American actor and cultural icon (Giant, Rebel Without a Cause), and 1st actor to be posthumously nominated for a Best Actor Academy Award. **1985** - Simone Signoret, German/French actress (Room at Top, Gina).
