
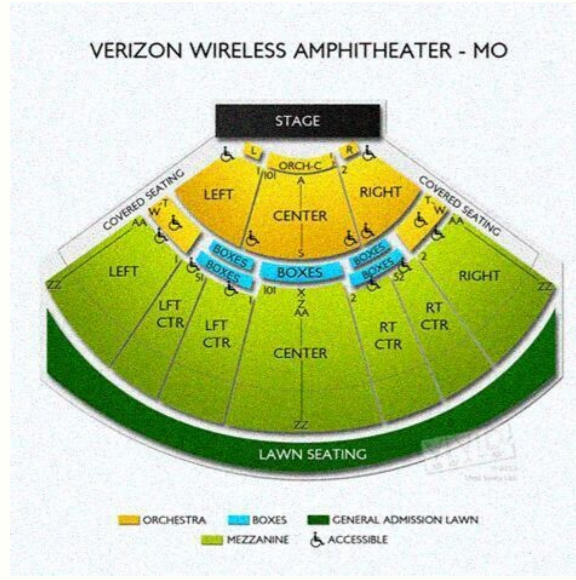

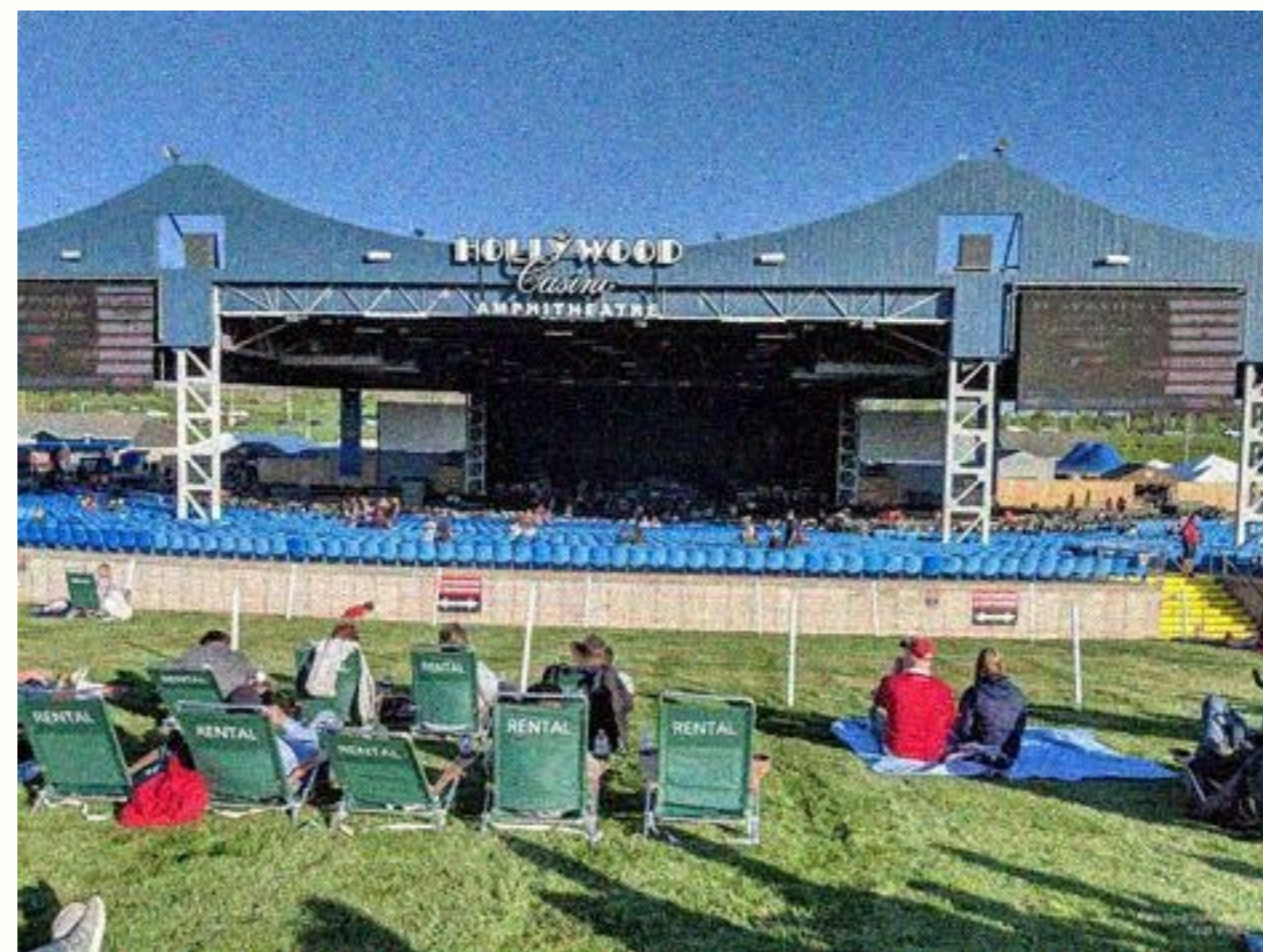

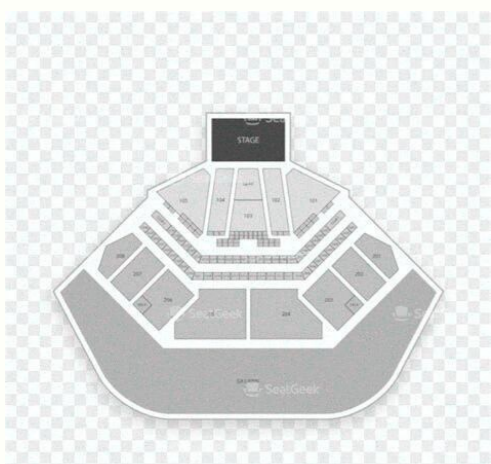

- Section Lawn - "Concert in Comfort" - **★★★★★** - This was my first time in the VIP boxes and I was very impressed. The seats were spacious and cozy, and I could adjust them to my liking. The VIP lounge was also very nice, with snacks and drinks and a private restroom. The view of the stage was good, but not the best.
- Section VIP Box Seats, Box 1 - "Probably No Better Seats" - **★★★★★** - These seats were perfect for me. They were on the aisle, so I had some extra space and easy access. They were also covered, so I didn't have to worry about the weather. And they were in front of the support beams, so I had a clear view of the stage. I don't think there are any better seats than these.
- Section 206, Row JJ, Seats 2-8 - "Great For Standing" - **★★★★** - These seats were ideal for standing and rocking out to the music. They were close to the stage and the sound was awesome. I felt like I was part of the show and the crowd. The only drawback was that there were no seats, so I had to stand for the whole time.
- Section Pit, Row GA - "Good for reserved" - **★★★** - These seats were not bad for reserved seating. They were a bit far from the stage, but I could still see the performers and the screens. The sound was also decent, but not very loud. The seats were comfortable and had cup holders, which was nice.
- Section 207, Row TT, Seat 78 - If you are looking for a hollywood amphitheater seating chart, you might want to check out the Credit Union 1 Amphitheatre in St. Louis. This venue, formerly known as Hollywood Casino Amphitheatre, can accommodate up to 28,000 people in its three sections: lawn, reserved, and VIP. The lawn is at the back of the venue, with a small reserved area on the left side of the stage. The reserved seats are in four sections, with 102-104 being the closest and most central to the stage. The VIP seats are elevated above the balcony suites and offer a better angle of the stage. The pit is in front of the stage and is a standing-only area. All lawn and pit seats are general admission, so you should get there early to secure your spot. The venue also has accessible seating options that you can buy online.
