Our mission is to empower the next generation of decision-makers and passionate students with a profound understanding of NATO's values, decision-making processes, political intricacies, and its pivotal role in transatlantic security.

During a four-day simulation, we will grant 96 students and young professionals from Germany and abroad the opportunity to address a hypothetical crisis scenario within the mechanisms and processes of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization. Filling the roles of National Representatives working in delegations, the students will have to coordinate their actions beyond their assigned committees and negotiate their standpoints within both the North Atlantic Council, the Military Committee, as well as a scenario-dependent third committee.

As the **Executive Assistant**, you will work directly with our Managing Director and Chairperson to ensure a smooth conference and lead-up throughout the year. Your tasks will include a range of activities, from planning and facilitating meetings to overseeing internal processes and communicating between different departments and external partners. Your exact responsibilities will be developed cooperatively with you based on your interests and skills, and involvement in other parts of the organization is definitely possible.

For this position, we are looking for people with strong organizational skills, high reliability, and a proactive attitude. Due to the scope of your tasks, holistic thinking will be a crucial component, alongside strong communication skills. Proficiency in the English Language is required; German proficiency might be useful. Prior experience in project management and a general interest in security policy and NATO-related issues are a plus.
