VINES

TERROIR

The vines are located on clay-limestone soil. The basement dates from the Kimmeridgian, typical of the Chablisian vineyard.

SITUATION

The vines are located in the south of the appellation on slopes of 10 to 20%

IN THE VINEYARD

Weeding is exclusively mechanical. The summer was dry, the disease pressure was low. The quality of the harvest was exceptional.

Surface area of the vineyard : 5 ha - **Age of vines**: 30 ans

VINIFICATION & MATURING

After rigorous settling, alcoholic fermentation took place slowly in good conditions for about 1 month. Malolactic fermentation is triggered naturally and quite quickly following it.

The aging in stainless steel vats took a short year on fine lees to give the wine all its roundness and aromatic complexity.

Alcohol content : 12,5 % vol.

SERVING & TASTING

Clear gold color. Nose with accents of white flowers and tangy fruits.

Elegant on the palate, offering a floral, mineral, gourmet fruity partition in a serrated style while restraint punctuated by beautiful bitter on the finish.

It will go well with your aperitifs, shellfish and crustaceans.

Ageing potential : 2 to 3 years - **Serving** : Service temperature is 12 à 14 °C.
