Dear parents and guardians of Hermann School,

the year 2022 is drawing to a close and Advent has begun. As usual, you will receive all information and dates worth knowing at the Hermann School in the new monthly letter "December 2022". However, I would like to start with a review of the past month:

The school registrations for the coming school year have taken place and the first counselling sessions regarding the choice of secondary schools as well as the parent-teacher conferences in the other classes / learning groups have been held.

On 18.11.2022, the Hermann School took part in the nationwide Reading Day on the theme of "Unique Together". All children of the school were read to by the teachers in different rooms of the school - the response of your children was consistently positive and the team of the Hermann School wishes for a repetition in the next school year.

I would like to thank you very much for coming and I would also like to thank my colleagues Mrs. Lutze and Mrs. Spielhoff who actively supported me during this information evening.

The fact that our school presents itself in an enchanting, pre-Christmas glow at the beginning of the new month is thanks to the many hard-working hands who painted, glued, sewed or even

baked fantastic works as part of the "Christmas handicrafts" on Friday, 25 November 2022.

On 06.12.2022 the St. Nicholas Caroling will take place in the corridors of the school. We will sing selected St. Nicholas songs together with your children, so that the mood for a contemplative Christmas time will also be set at the Hermann School on this day at the latest.
