Final size: 5.5 cm

#### MATERIAL

YARN (125m/50g) color of your choice, light blue, white

OTHER

FELT X

crochet hook 2.5 mm, fiberfill

#### SEWING THREAD

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#### BODY

---- color of choice

For the body, both legs are made first and then crocheted together.

## LEG 1

**R1:** work 6 sc in a ring

**R2:** inc 6 = 12 sts

- **R3-6:** sc 12
- Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

# LEG 2

- **R1:** work 6 sc in a ring
- **R2:** inc 6 = 12 sts
- **R3-6:** sc 12

In the next round the two legs will be crocheted together:

**R7:** insert your crochet hook into the stitches of Leg 1 and crochet 12 sc around Leg 1,



continue with the next regular stitch of Leg 2 and crochet 12 sc around Leg 2







• Use the yarn tail from Leg 1 to close the gap between the two legs.



**R8-17:** sc 24

 **R18:** 6x [sc 2, dec 1] = 18 sts

 **R19:** sc 18

 **R20:** 6x [sc 1, dec 1] = 12 sts

 • Stuff the body with fiberfill.

- **R21:** dec 6 = 6 sts
- Fasten off and leave a long tail.
- If necessary, stuff the body with more fiberfill and use the yarn tail to close the open end.



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#### VISOR

→ light blue

- **R1:** work 6 sc in a ring
- **R2:** 2x [sc 1, inc 2] = 10 sts
- **R3:** 2x [sc 2, inc 2, sc 1] = 14 sts
- **R4:** sc 14
- **R5:** slst 1
- Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.
- Sew the visor to the front of the body and stuff it slightly with fiberfill while sewing.



• If you want you can use white yarn to embroider a highlight on the visor.



### BACKPACK

#### 

- R1: work 8 sc in a ring
- **R2:** 4x [sc 1, 3 sc in 1 st] = 16 sts
- **R3:** 4x [sc 2, 3 sc in 1 st, sc 1] = 24 sts
- R4: In back loops only: sc 24
- **R5:** sc 24
- **R6:** In back loops only: 4x [sc 1, dec 2, sc 1] = 16 sts
- **R7:** dec 8 = 8 sts
- Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.
- Stuff the backpack with fiberfill.
- Use the loose yarn tail to close the open end and to sew the backpack to the back of the body.

Final size: 5 cm

#### MATERIAL

OTHER

YARN (125m/50g)

color of your choice and darker tone, white

#### **SEWING THREAD**

crochet hook 2.5 mm, fiberfill FELT

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#### BODY

For the body, both legs are made first and then crocheted together.

## LEG 1

**R1:** work 6 sc in a ring

**R2:** inc 6 = 12 sts

- **R3-6:** sc 12
- Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

## LEG 2

- **R1:** work 6 sc in a ring
- **R2:** inc 6 = 12 sts
- **R3-6:** sc 12

# In the next round the two legs will be crocheted together:

**R7:** insert your crochet hook into the stitches of Leg 1 and crochet 12 sc around Leg 1,



continue with the next regular stitch of Leg 2 and crochet 12 sc around Leg 2







• Use the yarn tail from Leg 1 to close the gap between the two legs.



#### **R8-12:** sc 24

*witch to a darker tone of color* 

- **R13:** In back loops only: 6x [sc 2, dec 1] = 18 sts
- **R14:** 6x [sc 1, dec 1] = 12 sts
- Stuff the body with fiberfill.
- **R15:** dec 6 = 6 sts
- Fasten off and leave a long tail.
- If necessary, stuff the body with more fiberfill and use the yarn tail to close the open end.



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#### BONE

→ white yarn

For the bone, two parts are made first and then crocheted together.

#### PART 1

- **R1:** work 6 sc in a ring
- **R2:** sc 6
- Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

#### PART 2

R1:	work 6 sc in a ring
R2:	sc б

In the next round the two parts will be crocheted together:

**R3:** insert your crochet hook into the stitches of Part 1 and crochet 6 sc around Part 1,



continue with the next regular stitch of Part 2 and crochet 6 sc around Part 2



= 12 sts

• Use the yarn tail from Part 1 to close the gap between the two parts.

R4: 2x [sc, dec 2, sc] = 8 sts
R5: sc 8
R6: slst 1



- Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.
- Stuff the bone slightly with fiberfill and sew it to the middle of the body.



#### BACKPACK

R1:	work 8 sc in a ring
R2:	4x [sc 1, 3 sc in 1 st] = 16 sts
R3:	4x [sc 2, 3 sc in 1 st, sc 1] = 24 sts
R4:	In back loops only: sc 24
R5:	sc 24
R6:	In back loops only:
	4x [sc 1, dec 2, sc 1] = 16 sts
R7:	dec 8 = 8 sts
Factor off and leave a long tail for

- Use the loose yarn tail to close the open end and to sew the backpack to the back of the body.
