Event: 1333 - Flood of the Arno River, causing massive damage in Florence as recorded by the Florentine chronicler Giovanni Villani. 1783 - Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart's "Symphony No. 36" premieres in Linz, Austria.
1852 - Count Camillo Benso di Cavour becomes the prime minister of Piedmont-Sardinia, which soon expands to become Italy. 1990 - Ayrton Senna retires with gearbox trouble during the season-ending Australian Grand Prix in Adelaide; wins by 7 points from Alain Prost; McLaren-Honda wins Constructors title for 3rd straight year.
2001 - "Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone" 1st film adaptation of the books premiers.
