**Event:** **1333** - Flood of the Arno River, causing massive damage in Florence as recorded by the Florentine chronicler Giovanni Villani. **1783** - Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart's "Symphony No. 36" premieres in Linz, Austria. **1852** - Count Camillo Benso di Cavour becomes the prime minister of Piedmont-Sardinia, which soon expands to become Italy. **1990** - Ayrton Senna retires with gearbox trouble during the season-ending Australian Grand Prix in Adelaide; wins by 7 points from Alain Prost; McLaren-Honda wins Constructors title for 3rd straight year. **2001** - "Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone" 1st film adaptation of the books premieres.
