Agricultural Report on Georgia #15

Weekly Highlights Survet results- In the II quarter of 2021, 127 cold storage facilities were active in Georgia, most of them were located in Shida Kartli region (49.6 percent). Active cold storage facilities are also located in Kakheti region (13.4 percent), in Tbilisi (10.2 percent), Kvemo Kartli region (7.9 percent), Adjara AR (7.1 percent), Samegrelo-Zemo Svaneti region (5.5 percent), Imereti region (3.9 percent), Mtskheta-Mtianeti region (1.6 percent) and Guria region (0.8

In the II quarter of 2021, the service was provided to 299 customers. The number of producers and resellers, from whom the product was purchased, totaled 254, while the annual average number of employed persons in cold storage facilities totaled 1263.

Exchange rate- As a result of August 5th, the value of one dollar became 3.1283 GEL and the value of one euro became 3.6648 GEL.

EU simplifies export procedures for Georgian hazelnuts

The European Union (EU) is simplifying the export procedures for Georgian hazelnuts as a result of an increased confidence in the quality of Georgian hazelnuts and an effective policy of state control, announces the National Food Agency of

Specifically, the standing committee on plants, animals, food and feed of the EU Commission's Directorate-General for Health and Food Safety has decided to reduce the frequency of inspection of Georgian hazelnuts exported to the EU. The agency reports that the decision of the committee was based on the measures taken by Georgia in 2020 to comply with the requirements of the European Union and to avoid aflatoxin contamination.


The decision was made on July 9 and will come into force on the twentieth day of

Georgia exported 18,000 tonnes of hazelnuts abroad in 2020, which is a 34% increase compared to 2019, says the Ministry of Agriculture of Georgia. To the EU alone Georgia exported 12,900 tonnes of hazelnuts last year, 59% more compared


Statistics show that 44% of agri-food exports from Georgia to the EU comes from hazelnuts, followed by wine (15%) and mineral waters (also 15%).


Detailed consumer price indices of Walnut in Georgia (Previous month = 100)

Choice nuts are produced by two Eurasian trees, the European filbert (Corylus avellana) and the giant hazel, o giant filbert (C. maxima), and by hybrids of these species with two American shrubs, the American hazelnut (C. americana) and the beaked hazelnut (C. cornuta). The large cobnut is a variety o the European filbert, and Lambert's filbert is a variety of the giant filbert. Nuts produced by the Turkish hazelnut (C. colurna) are sold commercially as Constantinople nuts. The former common name for the genus was hazel; various species were termed filbert, hazelnut, or cobnut, depending on the relative length of the nut to its husk, bu this distinction was found to be misleading.
