She instead need to show her ties to her family (any dependents?

parents etc...people who would make her return back home. Or if she owns property etc). Employment back home could be one reason for her to return, however she has a leave of absence which shows a weak link as far as her employment is concerned. Furthermore, she could have applied for a lesser period and not 3 months (Say 2-3 weeks). Basically the purpose of visit letter details her reasons to visit Canada and also shows that she intends to return to her home country I understood and thanks for your help. One question: if i had applied for outland sponsorship for my wife and she gets visitor visa also while the PR process going on. Do i need to change inform the IRCC and how? the question is do i need to or not? If you are asking whether you need to withdraw the outland application and apply inland, then NO. You do not need to. It is possible to have an outland application while the PA is in Canada (apparently they are processed faster than inland applications). The drawback is that if your wife is asked to attend an interview and she is by then in Canada, she will have to travel outside Canada to attend the interview. Yup,exactly that was my question.
