

OBETSUJI OJUYA HOYO (TEN NIGHT CHANTING SERVICE)

In Japan in the early fifteenth century in Kyoto they would have a chanting retreat that took place for over a period of ten days and ten nights. Based on the Sutra of the Buddha of Immeasurable Life (Muryoju-kyo). In Hawaii we observe O-juya in a one-day service called Nenbutsu day Service. On October 26^{th} we will chant Amida Buddha's name by hitting the fish drum and observing this special practice from 5 - 6 PM. Join us for an evening of meditation and chanting.
