Vienna-Marburg Combined	
Application deadline:	April 15th
Departure from US:	Saturday, July 30 th , 2022
Arrival overseas:	Vienna International Airport (VIE) on Sunday, July 31 st , 2022. All arrival times should be within the time window between 9 a.m. and noon.
Departure from site:	Frankfurt am Main International Airport (FRA). See below for dates.
Program dates:	31 July 2022 – 23 December 2022 OR in January 2023*
<p>* The Uni Marburg fall semester officially runs through February 10th, 2023, though fall semester-only Achievement students can make arrangements with their Uni professors to depart as early as December 23rd, 2022 if they need to return to their home campus for spring semester in early January. Achievement courses conclude before December 23rd.</p> <p>All students must be covered by DAK health insurance for the entire duration of their stay in the Federal Republic of Germany. The <i>Ausländerbehörde</i> will only issue residency permits for the timeframe where DAK coverage is in effect.</p>	
Scholarships available:	Social media. Inquire for more information.
Internships available:	German business internship. There are also several volunteering opportunities available in Marburg. Inquire for more information.
Language(s) of instruction:	German and English. The Uni Marburg also has a strong line-up of foreign language offerings, including Arabic, Hebrew, Spanish, Russian, French. Achievement reimburses students for one course per semester at the <i>Sprachenzentrum</i> with proof that the student passed the course.
Excursion dates:	Late September and early October orientation travel to Salzburg, Frankfurt am Main and Berlin.
Full year students:	Have a semester break from mid-February till early April. Achievement students keep and may stay in their housing over semester break.
